Our Overall Goal -

The average fifth grader is ten years old and on the brink...about to leave elementary school and enter the changing world of junior high. Students will soon begin to experience changes in body, values, and ability.

WCCA feels strongly that at the end of fifth grade, our students need to be firmly grounded for what lies ahead, so there is a strong emphasis on developing a solid command of the "basics." Our goal is to give our fifth graders a well-rounded mixture of skills they will use and need, presented to them in an interesting and "palatable" manner!

Curriculum Basics

The fifth grade **Bible** curriculum, Positive Action for Christ, presents a survey of the Old Testament. Students continue verse memorization and weekly chapels.

Imagine It!, WCCA's comprehensive **Reading and Language Arts** curriculum from SRA/McGraw-Hill, represents a substantial investment in providing the best for our students. This proven, research-based curriculum integrates spelling, grammar, reading, and writing into one cohesive program, with a strong emphasis on phonemic awareness, intentional phonics instruction, fluency, vocabulary, text comprehension, and writing strategies. Designed to meet the needs of students of varying abilities, the program engages all learners with high-interest literature, hands-on activities, cross-curricular connections, and critical thinking skills.

A Beka also provides our **Math** curriculum, which emphasizes multiplication tables through twelve, fractions, decimals, averaging, geometry, graphing, rounding and estimating numbers, multi-step story problems, factoring, measurement, and algebra.

ACSI Purposeful Design **Science** curriculum capitalizes on human curiosity about the world and its workings. It engages students in hands-on investigations, observation through the scientific method, and critically thinking about the world around them. Specifically, students study vertebrates, invertebrates, classification of animals, plants, cells, energy, matter, the atmosphere, endocrine system, weather, conservation, and technology in science. Students also learn the importance of healthy bodies, which are temples of the Holy Spirit.

A Beka is again the **Social Studies** curriculum of choice for teaching our students more about our nation's past. Throughout the year, we explore the periods of exploration and colonization, how our nation was established, the settling of the West, how the U.S. gained power in the world, and the U.S. today. In addition, students study states and their capitals and complete an in-depth state report.

Students experience a different culture & expand their understanding of language arts through instruction in our **Spanish** program.

The development of one's whole self must include physical activity, creativity, and musical understanding and expression. Therefore, rounding out our core curriculum, fifth graders receive weekly, age-appropriate instruction in **physical education** and **music**. Our music program includes opportunities for students to perform in an annual Christmas concert and spring chapel.

Fifth graders continue mastering their **library** skills in our library, specifically reviewing the Dewey Decimal System, and becoming more familiar with various research tools. In preparation for higher grades, they also receive more detailed **computer** instruction in our computer lab in the areas of keyboarding, word processing, spreadsheets, database, and graphics.

Peacemakers is a school-wide program to equip students with the social and biblical skills to appropriately handle conflict.

And finally, students participate in off-campus field trips throughout the year focusing on Art and Science experiences.
